Established as an outdoors educational facility, CWOC continues to build, focused on becoming a preferred retreat destination within the Lewis-Clark Valley and surrounding region; a place where people can gather, recreate, and learn in nature. Users will leave our facility with a greater understanding of sustainable approaches to natural resource management, and a holistic appreciation of them through outdoor experiences in a rustic setting - whether that experience is in the shape of an outdoor classroom, interactive workshop, a team-building challenge, recreational activities, or bespoke private events.

Our Facilities

CWOC is sustainably off grid. Built on private land, the camp facilities offer users a unique and safe remote experience within a beautiful, natural setting.

The facilities onsite include a lodge, a pavilion, two bunkhouses, a cook's cabin, outhouses, and two shower houses. We also have a firepit gazebo onsite, and an outdoor kitchen/dining area with propane grill and refrigerator/freezer (a separate cook's cabin is also available). CWOC's standard facilities include a centralized water system and on-demand hot water heater.

All electricity in the camp comes from solar power (the lodge, kitchen/dining areas, and the gazebo all have solar power connections).

Catering vendors and rental equipment are available in Lewiston for special event needs.

CWOC offers opportunities for many uses, from hands-on education and training courses to private camping experiences and special events (such as weddings). CWOC also has a dedicated area with a challenge course.
